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Professional Summary

I began my apprenticeship late in September of 1997 and acquired my State License to appraise residential real property in 2000. In 2007, I upgraded my license to become a State Certified Residential Real Property Appraiser.

Since becoming licensed, I have worked full-time as an independent residential fee appraiser. Over the years, my clients have included lending institutions, homeowners, attorneys, and investors. I have appraised residential properties for lending, divorce, litigation, tax appeals, pre-listing work, and private sales. I have expert witness experience testifying in divorce, litigation, and tax appeal cases, including at the state level.

I have appraised single-family homes, multi-family homes up to four units, condominiums, townhomes, and vacant land. As of January 1st, 2026, I have completed over 9,400 appraisals.

Since January of 2000, I have been working full-time as an Independent Residential Real Property Appraiser. I appraise properties for lending institutions, attorneys, homeowners, real estate agents, and investors. I appraise single-family homes, condominiums, town homes, two- to four-family income properties, and vacant land. In recent years, much of my appraisal work has been for the purpose of divorce, marriage dissolutions, tax appeals, private sales, and litigation. I also regularly perform appraisals for lending institutions. I have expert witness experience testifying in both divorce and tax appeal cases, including state-level tax appeal cases.
